

Information Murder Mystery Game “The Unfortunate Banker”

- Do-it-yourself murder game, no game host required;
- For groups of two to 200 people;
- Duration: a maximum of two hours excluding time to eat and breaks;
- Organizer can play along as well;
- Every player gets their own beautiful game booklet;

- Little preparation required, but taking care of the details is possible;
- Play anywhere: at home, at work or in the office, in a restaurant or anywhere you like;

DIY murder mystery game

Murder Mystery Game “The Unfortunate Banker” is **not** hosted by a game host but... **by the murder victim himself!** With a little help from you.

A few days after the **suicide** of **banker Warren Noble**, six family members and acquaintances receive a **letter** from his notary. In this letter, Noble claims he must have been **killed** by **one of them**. These **suspects** must **gather** and find out who is the **perpetrator** based on written **instructions** from Warren. He or she will be **punished** appropriately. This way the dirty laundry stays inside but the murderer does not get away with the murder.

Noble leads his own **murder investigation posthumously** in **writing**. His **instructions** and assignments are all in the **game booklets**. As

long as these are followed by all participants, the game will **unfold** by itself.

Occasions

Murder Mystery Game “The Unfortunate Banker” can be played with colleagues, friends or family and is suitable for **various occasions**: team outings, staff parties, bachelor parties, birthdays, family celebrations, you name it!

Children from around **12 years** of age can play, provided that the majority of the group consists of adults. There is **no maximum age**, so Uncle Fred and Aunt Flo can also participate.

Affordable

For groups with a **limited budget**, Murder Mystery Game “The Unfortunate Banker” is a perfect way to have a **full-fledged** murder mystery game **without the expense**. The game **booklets** are **reasonably priced** and if you take care of a **venue** yourself, your murder mystery party can remain **surprisingly affordable**.

Almost anywhere

Murder Mystery Game “The Unfortunate Banker” can be programmed almost **anywhere**: at home, at work, in a restaurant or hotel, a holiday home, etc. If the weather permits, it’s even possible to play the game **outdoors**.

Possible group sizes

The **minimum** group size is **two people**. With a **little** bit of **preparation** the game can be played with groups up to **200 people**. In this case someone needs to take the **lead** in order to control the **timing** of the game. Also a (small) **sound system** is needed. In the document **Rules of the Game**, which you receive with your order, you will find **possibilities** and **instructions** for large groups described in detail. We can also always provide more **information** and **support** by **telephone**.

Preparation of the game

The game **booklets** contain all **instructions** and **assignments**. If every participant has been given a booklet the game can be started, and everything will become **clear** along the lines. If you would like to, you can do the presentation **yourself** and **prepare** the game in detail.

How you would do this precisely, will be explained in the pdf document **Rules of the Game** which you will be sent along with your order.

Dividing characters and “acting”

The spoken **script** of Warren Noble and the six suspects will be **recited** by the participants. They determine **themselves** how theatrical and dramatic this happens. Of course **shy types** are **not** obliged to “act” but can sit back and fully focus on the murder investigation.

It is possible to **assign** a **role** to the players in advance. You will be the “casting agent” yourself. If you do this a **few days in advance** through the special **Invitation document** that you receive when you order the game, participants can **prepare** their role and even **dress appropriately**. This is **not required** of course but does give the game an extra dimension. Specific **instructions** for this can also be found in the document Rules of the Game.

The culinary part

Murder Mystery Game “The Unfortunate Banker” can be combined with **food**, from very simple to haute cuisine. It is possible to serve a dinner menu, lunch or High Tea during the game but tapas or sandwiches will also do just fine, it’s up to you. If you’d like to, you could even serve food in the **style** of the game. Especially for this you will receive some **matching recipes** with your order.
